The apricot (fruit of the *Prunus armeniaca*) is a drupe whose color varies from soft orange to ruby red. The plantation of these fruit trees is really widespread at our latitude (Italy), because of the rusticity and adaptability of the tree. In Southern Italy the first drupes mature at the end of April; the process goes on during the whole summer.

Origin	Italy – Apulia/Calabria/Emilia Romagna
Variety	Ninfa, Orange Rubis, Tom Cot, Big Red, Pinkot, Spring Blush.
Caliber	The caliber is measured in diameter mm. The minimum diameter is 35.
Characteristics	Apricots are rustic and very adaptable to changing weather conditions. On the market you can find some varieties that are completely orange, some with red facets and some others that are completely red. In May you can already find some apricots with a brix degree ≥ 11 .
Conservation	At a temperature of 2°C the product can be preserved for around 10 days.
Available packagings	- loose product: carton boxes (30x40) 5kg - punnet/tray: 500g, 1kg - other packagings available on request.
